The New Atheists fought hard for the right to say I don't believe. The Evidence-Based Strong Atheism era fights for the right to say and here is why God structurally cannot exist — backed by thermodynamics, ontology, the logic of creation, and theology's own internal contradictions.

The first era challenged religion's answers. The second era challenges religion's question itself: not "did God create the universe?" but "could a creator-God coherently exist anywhere inside the structure of reality at all?"

The Four Horsemen rode their course. The new era has a different vehicle: evidence.

The Two-Element Framework: Where God Has No Address
